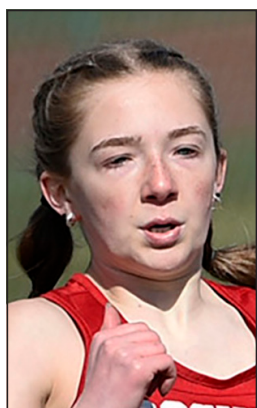

**Sydnee Boothby, Washougal**

After big cross country season, senior was the 2A state champion in the 800 meters and runner-up in 1,600 and 3,200.



**Casie Kleine, Castle Rock**

Sophomore won 1A state title in 400 meters, placed fifth in 200 and helped Rockets to fourth in 800 relay.



**Ruby Sereday, Kelso**

Senior saved her best for last: 11-foot personal record to win the 3A javelin state title with a throw of 130 feet, 4 inches.



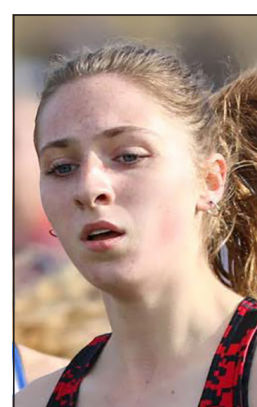
**McKenna Calkins, Ridgefield**

Just a freshman, Calkins placed fourth in the 100 at 2A state and anchored the Spudders' 400 relay that placed second.



**Alexis Leone, Seton Catholic**

Junior repeated as 1A state champion at 1,600 and 3,200 meters while also placing third in the 800 meters.



**Charlotte Wilson, Union**

Junior earned a third-place finish in the 3,200 at the 4A state meet and also qualified for state in the 1,600.



**Logan DeJong, Columbia River**

Junior's second-place finish in discus at 2A state meet (115-1) was top mark by River discus thrower since 2010.



**Eliisa Marshall, Camas**

Sophomore was a 4A state finalist in the 400 and 800 meters and anchored Camas' state champion 1,600 relay team.



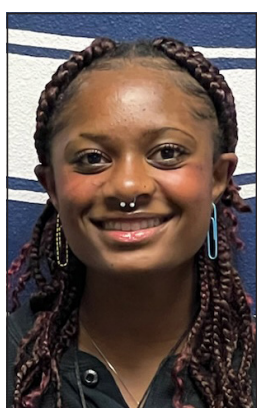
**Leibreena Vaiotaulemoso-Fesili, Fort Vancouver**

Junior had the state's top mark in the 2A shot put (39-4.5) this spring and placed second in the event at the state meet.



**Rielee Gourde, Kelso**

Senior placed fifth at 3A state meet in the javelin and sixth in the pole vault, helping Kelso capture team title.



**Emem Ntekpere, Skyview**

CWU-bound senior was the 4A state runner-up in the high jump, placed fourth in the 300 hurdles and sixth in 100 hurdles.
