Sydnee Boothby, Washougal

After big cross country season, senior was the 2A state champion in the 800 meters and runner-up in 1,600 and 3,200.



McKenna Calkins, Ridgefield

Just a freshman, Calkins placed fourth in the 100 at 2A state and anchored the Spudders' 400 relay that placed second.



Casie Kleine, Castle Rock

Sophomore won 1A state title in 400 meters, placed fifth in 200 and helped Rockets to fourth in 800 relay.

Alexis Leone, Seton Catholic

Junior repeated as 1A state champion at 1,600 and 3,200 meters while also placing third in the 800 meters.

Eliisa Marshall, Camas

Sophomore was a 4A state finalist in the 400 and 800 meters and anchored Camas' state champion 1,600 relay team.

Emem Ntekpere, Skyview

CWU-bound senior was the 4A state runner-up in the high jump, placed fourth in the 300 hurdles and sixth in 100 hurdles.

Ruby Sereday, Kelso

Senior saved her best for last: 11-foot personal record to win the 3A javelin state title with a throw of 130 feet, 4 inches.

Charlotte Wilson, Union

Junior earned a third-place finish in the 3,200 at the 4A state meet and also qualified for state in the 1,600.



Leibreena Vaiotaulemoso -Fesili, Fort Vancouver

Junior had the state's top mark in the 2A shot put (39-4.5) this spring and placed second in the event at the state meet.
