Josiah Alanis, **Evergreen**

Sophomore owned the region's top long jump mark this spring and placed fourth at the 3A state meet (22 feet).

Arthur Ban, **Evergreen**

The junior hit a personal best in the high jump (6 feet, 4 inches) to earn fifth place at the 3A state meet.



Isaiah Cowley, **Ridgefield**

Senior earned a runner-up finish in the 300-meter hurdles and placed sixth in the 110-meter hurdles at the 2A state meet.

Ryan Faumuina, **Fort Vancouver**

Junior who placed third at the 2A state meet in shot put was one of four regional athletes to surpass 50 feet this spring.





Tony Peonio, Kalama

Junior won the 2B state championship in the pole vault with a height (14-6) that would have placed him third at 4A meet.

Sam Sheppert, **Skyview**

Senior made the most of his first Class 4A state meet appearance by placing fifth in the 800 meters in a time of 1:56.96.



Revac Banfield, **Columbia River**

Sophomore posted the region's top 100-meter time (10.67) and placed fourth at 2A state in the 100 and 200.

Grayson Caldwell, Union

Junior placed fifth in the 400 meters at 4A state meet and ran on Union's 4x400 relay team that reached the state final.





Senior placed third in the 1A state meet in both the 100 and 200 meters and ran on both state-qualifying relay teams.

Chase McGee, Camas

Sophomore was 4A GSHL field athlete of the year and placed 2nd in pole vault at 4A state meet with personal-best 14-9.

Jared Williams, Camas

Junior placed second in the Class 4A state meet in the javelin and also posted top mark this year in Class 4A (183-3).
