


Lauren Dreves, Columbia River

Lizzy Andrew, Ridgefield

The 6-foot-5 senior and Stanford commit had 190 kills with a .450 hitting percentage, 37 stuff blocks and 71 aces.



Sydney Dreves, Columbia River

The junior outside hitter had a teamhigh 234 digs along with 248 kills and a .445 hitting percentage.



Kendall Mairs, **Camas**

The junior hitter/ setter earned 4A GSHL co-MVP honors. Had 249 kills, 318 assists and 218 digs and 54 aces.



Macey McCoy, **Columbia River**

The senior setter averaged 29.2 assists over 24 matches and earned first-team all-league honors. Also had 135 digs.



Halle Reiter, **Camas**

Senior libero and Santa Clara commit was the 4A GSHL co-MVP with 265 digs and 50 aces, leading Camas to sixth at state.

Emelynn Cecil, Prairie

The senior libero averaged 12.1 digs in 3A GSHL play. Led the Falcons to a 3A GSHL title and fifth place at state.



Logan DeJong, **Columbia River**

The senior middle blocker and versatile role-player had 35 blocks, 110 kills and a hitting percentage of.355.



Makena Gamby, **Mountain View**

The senior was the 3A GSHL co-MVP and helped earn the program's third state berth with 322 assists, 282 digs and 184 kills.



Hailey McEllrath, Ridgefield

The six-foot senior has committed to play at Lamar and had 118 kills with a .373 hitting percentage and 31 stuff blocks.



Ali Millspaugh, **Prairie**

The senior outside hitter was the 3A GSHL co-MVP, recording doubledigit kills in six of nine league matches.
